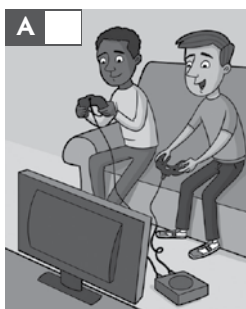

With other verbs, we use this word order: **subject + adverb of frequency + verb.**

✗ *He always is friendly.*

✓ *I often watch football on TV.*

✗ *I watch often football on TV.*

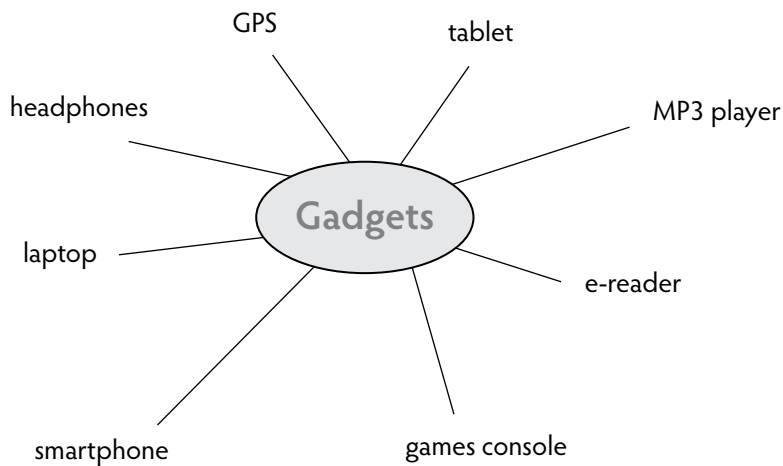

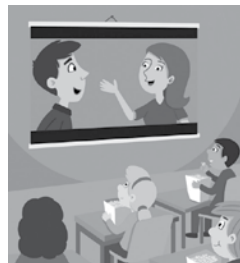

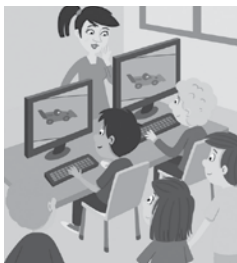
